Bubba Dewey's Little House *by Artist, Mira Scott*

When the painter Mira Scott moved to Hilton Head Island in 1978, one of the photographs she took for inspiration was of a little house on Gumtree Road. She vowed then that one day she would paint that house, but the photograph sat with other photographs waiting to be painted.

In 2006, as Mira was working on a painting with this house in it, she happened to see an article in *The Island Packet* with a photo of Louise Cohen, the founder and director of The Gullah Museum of Hilton Head Island. Mrs. Cohen was standing in front of the little house and Mira learned it was to become part of the Museum, once the funds had been raised to restore it. Mira then contacted Mrs. Cohen to share her story of the painting 'Bubba Dewey's Little House.'

EMORY SHAW CAMPBELL

The contributions of Emory Shaw Campbell to the cultural and environmental heritage of South Carolina are enormous. He is Executive Director Emeritus of Penn Center, located on St. Helena Island, SC. During his twenty-two-year tenure he engaged diverse groups in applying methods of preserving and enhancing the unique and rich Gullah cultural and environmental heritage in the Sea Islands. He earned his Bachelor of Science degree in biology from Savannah State College in 1965 and a MS in Environmental Engineering from Tufts University in Boston in 1971.

Mr. Campbell has appeared in many documentaries, news magazines, films and radio and television programs, including *60 Minutes*; *The Today Show*; a PBS special, *Family Across the Sea*; as well as on C-Span's *Washington Journal*. His honors include the *Governor's Award for Historic Preservation (1999)* the *Carter G. Woodson award for Civil Rights (2005)*. He was inducted into the South Carolina Black Hall of Fame (1999), and was awarded an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters by Bank Street College, N.Y. 2000, and by the University of South Carolina in 2012. He authored the *guide Book "Gullah Cultural Legacies"* in 2005.

He is currently President of **Gullah Heritage Consulting Service that conducts institutes on Gullah Cultural heritage and related issues through lectures, short courses and the Gullah Heritage Trail Tours on Hilton Head Island.**
